**THE PARTICIPANTS:** aspiring school leaders and advanced teachers - should have a good level of English.

Many schools struggle with developing a whole school approach to embedding the use of technology in teaching and learning.

This workshop is designed for aspiring school leaders and advanced teachers to:

- ✓ explore strategies for whole school development and improvement using technology;
- ✓ to understand the main issues for mainstreaming best practice;
- ✓ to identify a specific development focus at classroom level and school level; and
- ✓ to implement change with peer support.

Participants will be introduced to the 'Framework for Mainstreaming Change' and a series of ten investigations that can be undertaken by teachers within their own schools, with a strong focus on mainstreaming the use of ICT to support whole school development.

The workshop includes two follow-up online seminars (webinars) where the progress of the schools is tracked and shared. Change doesn't happen overnight, and therefore the participants should commit to work on the topic on a long-term and take an active role in the follow-up activities.
